EMPOWER WOMEN—Microcredit



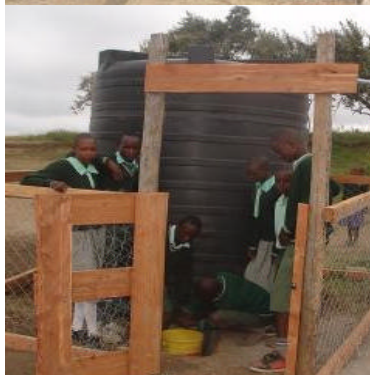
